Airport

Dublin International Airport (DUB)

Distance from Hotel: 9km (15-minute drive, approximately €30 taxi)

Arriving by Train:

The closest railway station is Drumcondra at the intersection of Drumcondra Road (N1) and Clonliffe Road, a 5 minute walk from the stadium.

The closest DART stations are Connolly and Clontarf. Connolly is a 15-20 minute walk and Clontarf a 20-25 minute walk to the stadium. The closest LUAS & Intercity Rail stop is also at Connolly Station.

Arriving by Bus:

Take the No 3, 11, 11a 16, 16a and 41 from the City Centre to Drumcondra Road.

Entrance to Conference Meeting Space

If you are staying at the Croke Park Hotel, you can access the Croke Park Conference Center through the Hogan Stand entrance, located just across Jones's Road from the hotel. Signage in the stadium lobby will direct you to the event space. Once inside, turn left and take Lifts 2 & 3 to Level 4 (Hogan Mezzanine).
